2. The website would have a free-speech area for discussion.
3. The website would largely use large type so it is easily read by older people.
4. The website would simulate the calcsea (<http://www.calcsea.org>) website.
5. The website would contain meta tags for optimal search engine submission.
6. The website would have a site map submitted to Google, for better search engine performance.
7. The website would be submitted to many search engines.
8. The website would help bring new members.
