Ron carefully showed how to compute the moving averages. He showed how the exponential moving average was easier to compute than the simple (additional) moving average.

Ron walked us through several websites that use moving averages, showing how to customize these charts.

Ron said that these technical analysis methods, based entirely on past prices, were not great predictors, but that some of the technical methods he would show in the future were more helpful and predictive.
